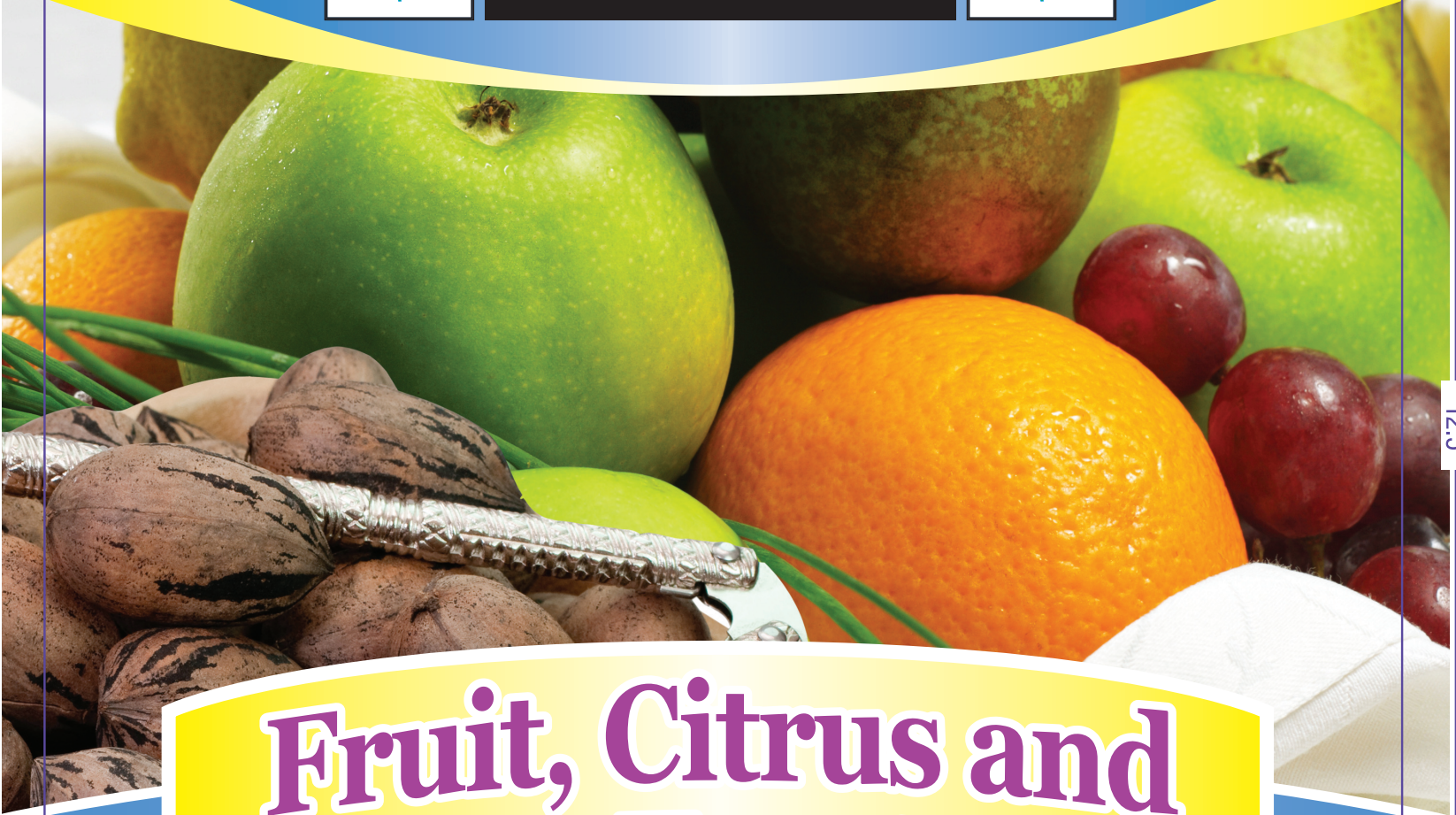

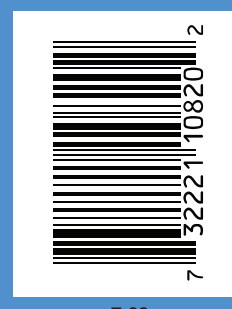

GROWING GUIDE	
FRUIT TREES	
APPLICATION	
Apple	Apply 3/4 lb. per 31/2 inches of trunk diameter. Broadcast evenly on ground out under widest spread of branches (drip line) and water thoroughly. Apply in early Spring.
Pear, Apricot	Apply 1/4 lb. per 31/2 inches of trunk diameter. Broadcast evenly on ground around drip line of tree in Spring and repeat once six weeks later. Gradually increase amount of fertilizer each year until 5 lbs. are used per tree annually.
Peach, Cherry	Apply 3/4 lb. of fertilizer during the first year of growth. Broadcast evenly on ground around drip line of tree in Spring and repeat once six weeks later. Gradually increase amount of fertilizer each year until 5 lbs. are used per tree annually.
Plum	Apply 1 lb. of fertilizer during the first year of growth. Broadcast evenly on ground around drip line. Feed each Spring thereafter, increasing each year until 2 to 3 lbs. are used per tree annually.
Citrus Trees Orange, Grapefruit, Lemon, Lime and Tangerine	Apply 1 lb. of fertilizer per inch of trunk diameter per feeding in early Spring, Summer, and Fall at 90 day intervals.
Nut Trees Pecan, Walnut, Chestnut, and Hickory Nut	Apply 2 1/2 to 3 lbs. of fertilizer per inch of trunk diameter annually in the early Spring before new growth appears and after Harvest. Apply around drip line.

2. How do you use it?
Pecans, Hickory Nuts, Black Walnuts, Hazelnuts, Chestnuts, etc.: Feed your Nut Trees twice a year, (in early Spring before new growth appears and after harvest) using the quantities listed below at each feeding.

Apples, Pears, Peaches, Plums, Cherries, Oranges, Grapefruit, Lemons, etc.: Feed your Fruit Trees twice a year, (in early Spring before blooms or new growth appears, and after fruit is ripe or picked) using the quantities below at each feeding.
