



Foam Fixer

Pet Peeve™ Foam Fixer™ is a convenient, ready-to-use foam containing natural probiotic, scum-eating, odor eliminating microbes and citrus oil.

The microbes clean the way Mother Nature intended, by eating the stain or odor causing molecules at the source rather than using harsh chemicals.

Directions for Use

Pet Peeve Foam Fixer will need to be in contact with the affected area for a period of time (at least two hours is ideal) to be most effective. When applying to fabric or carpet, the product should be spot tested on a discrete area first for color fastness. Do not use with bleach or other chemicals.

Carpet & Upholstery

Foam Fixer can be used to treat a variety of stains and odors on carpet and upholstery such as urine, fecal matter, vomit, and drool. For best results, apply immediately while the stain is still wet. If the stain has dried, moisten the area with water first. Multiple applications of Foam Fixer may be necessary for very dark stains, or old stains. Spray Foam Fixer over the stain, completely covering it with foam. For deep carpet stains, scrub the product into the weave for faster results. Sometimes it may even be necessary to moisten the carpet down to the sub floor. Avoid excessively soaking carpet or upholstery. Allow the foam to completely dissipate on the stain. If the foam dries and the stain is still present, then moisten with water to reactivate the microbes. The microbes need moisture to do their work. Foam Fixer also works well on soda, juice, milk, wine, beer, food residue, oil, and most other organic matter.

Dogs

Spray Foam Fixer onto a dog's favorite spots to make a mess in the house to eliminate any subtle odors that are attracting the dog to repeatedly use those areas. It is also ideal for eliminating odors on reusable indoor pee pads and potty training pads. Rinse the pad with water, then spray Foam Fixer in a sweeping motion over the entire pad and let dry. Pet stains on upholstery or carpet may also be treated as noted in the above section.

Cats

To reduce litter box odors, spray Foam Fixer in a sweeping motion to coat the box, then pour a normal amount of litter directly on top. If a clumping litter is used, let the foam dry for a few minutes before pouring litter over the top. Foam Fixer is not a substitute for regularly emptying a litter box.

Small Caged Pets

Foam Fixer is ideal for treating odors from hamster, guinea pig, rabbit, ferret, bird or any other small animal cages. It also works great on skunk odors. Spray Foam Fixer on the bottom of animal cages, or other affected areas, where it will go to work immediately to neutralize odors and begin digestion of organic matter making cleanup easier. If a cage lining or bedding is used, spray Foam Fixer first then place the lining or bedding over the product. Ferret hammocks and play areas are also ideal areas to be treated. Any items treated with Foam Fixer should be allowed to dry completely before reintroducing the animal. Foam Fixer is not a substitute for regular cage cleaning.

Other Household Uses

Treat smelly trash cans using a sweeping motion to coat the sides of the bin before putting in a new bag. Foam Fixer is also great for treating organic build-up and odors in garbage disposals and drains. Moisten the drain first by running some water. Then turn the can upside down and inject foam directly into the drain or garbage disposal. Let it sit for a few hours or overnight before running water.

Common Sense Precautions

Do not apply to food or direct food contact surfaces. Avoid directly breathing spray mist. Do not allow children to apply product. If more than an incidental amount is swallowed, seek medical attention. Give one glass of water and do not induce vomiting. Wash hands well after use and before eating or smoking. If in eyes, remove contacts and flush with water for 15 minutes. Seek medical attention for any persistent irritation. Store out of reach of children and in a closed, appropriately labeled container between 35 and 95 °F. This is a pressurized aerosol can – store away from ignition sources.
